

Storrington in Bloom Local Competition (residential categories) rules:

All entrants must be situated in the Parish of Storrington & Sullington.

The competition is free to enter and the judges decision is final.

The competition is run by Storrington in Bloom Working Group, a partnership of Greenfingers, Storrington Horticultural Society, Storrington Allotments Association, Friends of Meadowside and Storrington Conservation Society.

The addresses of the top 6 front gardens and community areas will be published after the judging to encourage the local residents and community to view.

A selection of entries may be shown to the judges of the South & South East in Bloom regional competition during their visit to Storrington on Thursday 13th July.

Judges will be looking for a colourful display of flowers and foliage which may include: bedding plants, herbaceous plants, shrubs, trees, lawns, baskets and containers.

Short-listing of entries will take place during July ready for final judging early in August.

FRONT GARDEN - open to all private residential premises. Front gardens must be visible to passers by.

COMMUNITY AREA - open to groups of residents and tenants organisations wishing to nominate shared and communal gardens or groups of gardens in a street or estate.

Entries must be received by 5pm Friday 30th June 2017.
