

Storrington in Bloom Scarecrow Competition rules:

The competition is free to enter.

The competition is run by Storrington in Bloom Working Group, a partnership of Storrington Horticultural Society, Storrington Allotments Association, Greenfingers, Friends of Meadowside and Storrington Conservation Society.

To participate entrants must submit completed entry forms by Friday 30th June and have their scarecrow on display between 9am and 5pm on Saturday 8th and Sunday 9th July.

Completed entry forms can be submitted by email to storringtoninbloom@gmail.com or by hand to Joanna's Boutique Tearoom, The Card Centre or Wood'n'pots'n'things.

Entries must be 4ft tall or higher. Scarecrows need a name which should be displayed for identification purposes.

Entries must be visible from the roadside. If you are unable to find somewhere to display your scarecrow please contact us and we will organise a space for you (subject to availability and on a first come first served basis).

Participants are responsible for arranging transport of their scarecrow.

A selection of entries may be shown to the judges of the South & South East in Bloom regional competition during their visit to Storrington on Thursday 13th July.

Entries must be received by 5pm Friday 30th June 2017. The judges' decision is final. Winners will be announced at the Storrington in Bloom awards ceremony on Wednesday 20th September 2017.
